 Since coming here he had owned and operated the Bittel Service Station and also farmed. Mr. Bittel had been active in Grange work for 60 years.
 Surviving are his widow, Hannah, who he married on Dec. 25, 1920; a son, Norman of route 2 Scottville; three grandchildren and two brothers, William of Avon Park, Fla. and Albert of Lakeland, Fla.

Hannah Mortensen, was born Jan. 2., 1889, in East Lake, Mich. She attended school in rural Manistee County. She was married to Charles Bittel on Dec. 25, 1920, who preceded her in death in 1967.

She was a lifetime member of the Victory Grange and Pomona Grange. She moved to Scottville in 1940 and has resided there ever since. She assisted her husband in business at the Bittel Service Station until retiring in 1966. She is survived by one son, Norman Bittel of Scottville, two half sisters, Mrs. Al (Marie) Dahlquist of Manistee, and Mrs. Arthur (Dagney) Foelker of Largo, Fla., three grandchildren and one great grandchild. Funeral services will be held at 1 p.m. in the Stephens Chapel with the Rev. John Christensen officiating. Burial will be in Brookside Cemetery.
