David C. Routson, being of lineal descent of the Routson Family, gives here, for the benefit of the Reunion, the genealogy of the Routson Family, so far as he is able to trace.

John Routson emigrated from Germany about the year 1760 and landed in Maryland near Hagerstown. Of this family I have account of two sons, David and Jonathan, David being my grandfather. He was born in Germany, growing to manhood in Maryland. He married a woman by the name of Sarah Roberts and moved to Gettysburg, Pennsylvania, where my father was born in 1796. She (Sarah) was closely related to the founder of the Roberts College of Scotland. Grandfather bought her by paying the Captain of the vessel her passage money across the ocean. there was born to that union four boys whose names were John, Jonathan, Daniel, and David. Later Jacob was born, this making five sons. The names of the girls were: Susan, Mary, Catherine, and Sarah. Grandfather left Maryland and came west and settled in Columbiana county, Ohio, in the year 1811, where his wife died. He married again a widow by the name of Elizabeth Campbell and to this union there were six children born. Of the boys there were Ezra and Joel. the girls were: Catherine, Anna, Kesiah, and Bridget. Now this brings us with this family down to the present day.

My father, John Routson, married in Columbiana County, Ohio, to a woman by the name of Jane Campbell and shortly after moved to Holmes County, Ohio, where this writer was born in 1837. Of this union there were ten girls and two boys. Of the girls there were: Sarah, Margaret, Alice, Clarissa, Rachel, Anna, Elizabeth, Lettita, and Coraline. Anna and Elizabeth died in infancy. The rest of the girls reared families, with the exception of Lettita. Margaret married a man by the name of Booth and went to the state of Oregon in 1847. Sarah married a man by the name of Catting, her descendants live in Kansas. Alice married a man by the name of Bond, her family mostly resides here. Her second husband was a Williamson. Rachel married a man by the name of Green, her family reside in Bluffton, Ohio. Lettita married a man by the name of I. N. Teatsworth. One child was born to this union.

Clarissa married a man by the name of Duer. they reside in Iowa. Caroline married a man by the name of Williamson. Her descendants are somewhere in Texas. David C. Routson married Mary Bare of Hancock County, Ohio in 1861 and of this union there were twelve children born. Boys: George W., John D., David E. E., Warren J., Jason H., Wilbur W., and Harvey. Girls: Genette, Jennie, Margaret, Ugenie and Viva. Jennie, Ugenie, and Harvey have gone before and all the others reside in Hancock County, Ohio, except George W. who now resides in Michigan.

George W. Routson, brother of the writer, enlisted in the 21st Ohio in 1861, served his time in the 100th day service and afterward in the 57th and lost his life at Shiloh, while leading his Company in the fight. This happened when he was only nineteen years of age.

Of my Uncle, David married Sallie Campbell, a sister of my mother and some of his descents reside in Ada, Ohio, and others in Illinois. Daniel married a Lenheart, one boy is now living. His name is David. Jonathan died in Columbiana County while young. Jacob, while in the U.S. Service, lost his life in the Missouri River by a boat capsizing while bearing dispatches. Ezra lives in Wood County near Portage. Joe lives in Findlay, Ohio. Now to go back to John Routzon, Senior, my great grandfather. His son Jonathan was father of Enoch and George Rout son on McComb, Ohio and I will leave their descendants to trace their families further.

I have heard my father speak of one, a Nathan Routzon, but I am unable to trace him, also a cousin of my father, he called "Little John Routzon". His whereabouts are unknown.

In regard to the name Routzon. The original name was spelled Rountenzon as I have it from my grandfather direct, but other branches of the family spelled it Routzhan. The name originated in Germany. At one time they were called Rouenzoneiz, the name of the certain locality from which they were from.

I will now close by saying a few words in regard to our tribe. While few of us have pushed ourselves forward, we have tried to be good men in the common walks of life. I know of no one that was ever arrested for a criminal offense, as they all believe in the "Brotherhood of men. As far as the writer of this History, he never had a lawsuit nor does he expect one.
