General Notes (Husband)

I have a picture of the tombstone on George and Allen Bond's grave in Maple Grove Cemetery, Findlay, OH. On the west side of the stone is inscribed, "George A. Bond, died 19 Jan 1854 aged 52y 4m 25d" and on the east side, "Allen Bond Son of G & A Bond died Feb 8 1854 1y 1m 1d." A daughter, Orpah, was born to Alice Bond 24 Feb 1854. It must have been a trying time for Alice, losing her husband in January, her year old son on February 8th, and giving birth to their only daughter on February 24th. Is it possible George and Allen died from the same cause?

Will of Alice Bond Williamson

"I Alice Williamson wife of Jonathan Williamson of Eagle Township, Hancock County, Ohio....hereby numinate and appoint my son John W. Williamson to be the executor.....After my death I direct that my executor shall sell all my real estate, at public or private sale and convey the same to the purchase there of by Deed in fee simple.....The proceeds of said real estate my executor shall divide and pay to my children in the following portions to wit..To Aaron D Bond, Arthur W. Bond and Orphy J. (Bond) Garling, each fifty Dollars to be paid to them severally as soon as my real estate is converted into money....To James Williamson, John W. Williamson and Margaret A Williamson each one fourth 1/4 of the balance after the Bond children are paid. And the remaining one fourth 1/4 of said balance my executor shall pay to Clarissa L Leaf and her son William H. each one half of said remaining one fourth.....In witness whereof I hereto set my hand and seal this 17th day of December A.D. 1887. Alice X (her mark) Williamson.
