

Bond Services to Be Saturday

Funeral services for Mrs. Honora Bond, 72, of Elsie Route 2, who died yesterday, will be held at 2:30 p.m. Saturday at the Jennings-Lyons Chapel with the Rev. A. F. Niemann and the Rev. Imogene Quinn officiating. Burial will be in Riverside Cemetery, Henderson.
