Born 1 August 1808

Occupation: Weaver (tisserand)

Son of Antoine Krauth, farmer, age 53 ( cinquante trois) and Therese Mathis,  
deceased

Catharine Karg was 28 years of age and born in Niederschaeffolsheim

Born Sept 1802

“le Sept du mois de (the month of second month of the calender of the first  
French Republic from Oct 22 to Nov 20) Brumaire an douze dela Republic “

Daughter of Joseph Karg, farmer, age 52 and Anne Marie Weis age soixanti  
deux (62 or 72)
