## General Notes for Child Peter POWELL [409]

1) Memorial History of The Powell Family by Rev John Powell - "In 1795 he came with his parents to Mifflin County, Pa., but afterward returned to Schuylkill County Pa. He married Mary Alspaugh, daughter of Henry Alspaugh, and a sister to John Powell's wife. After his marriage he rented a farm on the Juniata River, in Mifflin County, and carried on farming until 1814. In 1814 Mr. Powell, having now a wife and nine children, concluded to move to Fairfield County, Ohio and make that their future home....They moved to Hancock County, Ohio, in 1858, where they died." Page 43-Peter Powell with his family, moved to Bloon Township, Fairfield County, Ohio where he bought 320 acres of land. Page 44-he succeeded in providing for each child 160 acres of land, mostly in Seneca and Hancock counties, Ohio.

## General Notes for Child Jacob POWELL [410]

1) Memorial History of The Powell Family by Rev. John Powell 1880 Page 162-163 - Jacob Powell, son of Philip Powell, was born in Berks County, Pa., February 4, 1779. In 1810 or 1812 he went to Hardy county, Virginia, where, in March, 1813 he married a young lady by the name of Mary Ann Idelman. They were blessed with ten children, wight of whom are still living.

## General Notes for Child John Philip POWELL [411]

1) Memorial History of The Powell Family by Rev. John Powell 1880 Page 48 - John Philip Powell married Elizabeth Raudebaugh, daughter of Nicholas Raudebaugh, of Schuylkill County, Pa. Eight days after his marriage, Mr. Raudebaugh and his family and Mr. Powell and his young wife started for Fairfield County, Ohio, where Mr. Raudebaugh had previously entered some land.

2) In 1825 he went to Hopewell Twp., Seneca Co., OH and entered 320 acres of land. In 1827 he went to Hancock Co., OH and entered 480 acres of land, in Blanchard and Union Twp.; and afterward he entered 900 acres more in Hancock County.

3) All of Philip Powell's family record is in the hand-writing of John Philip Powell in the family bible. I (Rev. John Powell) also found the following record in the same Bible, in the hand-writing of his two youngest sons: John Philip Powell was born May 2 1781, and died April 4, 1849 at one o'clock A.M., aged 67 years 11 months and 5 days. He was buried April 6, when two funeral sermons were preached-one in German and one in English. The former preached from Phil.i.21 and the later from Hebrews vii. 25. Elizabeth Powell, consort of John Philip Powell, was born October 17, 1787 and died October 22, 1862, at one o'clock A.M. aged 75 years and 5 days. Her disease was palsy and bilious fever.

She was born in Berks County, Pa., in 1789, and was married, probably in 1809 to John Corkle, who was born in Berks County, Pa., about 1788, and was a soldier in the war of 1812-14. He went as a substitute, and remained until the close of the war.

For some years after their marriage they lived on her father's farm, in Mifflin County, Pa., where some of their children were born. They moved to Hancock county, Ohio, in 1837, where they remained ten years, and then moved to Mercer County, Ohio, where both parents died. Mr. John Corkle died March, 8th, 1859, aged 71 years. Mrs. Susannah Corkle died July 19th, 1860, aged 71 years."

### General Notes for Child Catherine POWELL [924]

Memorial History of The Powell Family by Rev. John Powell 1880 - "Catherine Powell was the mother of three children, name Jane, John, and Henry William. Jane was married first to David Lowry, and after his death to John Carter. John and Henry William live in Illinois. Catherine Powell died in Mifflin County, Pa., in 1848"

### General Notes for Child Daniel POWELL [925]

1) Daniel and family traveled with Elizabeth & Charles Phillips to Hancock Co., OH. source-Biography of Katherine Anne Fetters, author unknown.

2) Memorial History of The Powell Family by Rev. John Powell - "Daniel & Elizabeth (Norton) Powell lived at the foot of Jack Mountain, Mifflin County, Pa., where all their children were born. In 1833 he moved with his family to Hancock County, Ohio, where his wife died in 1834. Mr. Powell, after his wife died, and when the children were all able to take care of themselves, concluded to travel and see the country. He left home in 1845 and went to the great West. In the last letter he wrote to his children, he stated that he was then on a raft of lumber, going down the Mississippi river toward New Orleans, where he intended to sell out and then return again, taking the Ohio River, and go first to Pennsylvania, and then return home again to Ohio. But nothing more was ever heard of him, and the supposition is that he perished on the river."
