John Dandison made his declaration of intent on the 10th day of May, 1856 which is recorded in Libra 1 on page 121 Declarations of Intent. John's Final Oath was 15 March 1860 and is recorded in Libra 8, page 10 in the Circuit Court Journals.

ROBERT DANDISON, 14 Sept 1842 (4:10)CC 15 Oct 1844 (0:129) DC ENG (Also entered 15 Oct 1844 (0:21)f oaths by Benjamin Packerman and Peter Stiles)
Robert Dandison declared on the 14th day of Sept 1842 his intentions of becoming a citizen of the United States of America and it is recorded in Oakland County, Michigan Courthouse in Pontiac, Michigan in Circuit Court Journals Libra 4 page 10 . He took the final oath on the 15th day of Oct 1844 and it is recorded in Oakland County, Michigan Courthouse in Pontiac, Michigan in District Court Journals, Libra 0, page 129

The Final Oath is also recorded in District Court Journals, Libra 0, page 21. Oaths were given by Benjamin Packerman and Peter Stiles.
